- 1. CAT. Young musicians born after 01/01/2009. Free program with a maximum duration of 3 minutes.
- 2. CAT. Young musicians born after 01/01/2007. Free program with a maximum duration of 5 minutes.
- 3. CAT. -Young musicians born after 01/01/2005. Free program with a max. duration of 5 minutes.
- 4. CAT. Young musicians born after 01/01/2002. Free program with a max. duration of 5 minutes.
- 5. CAT. Young musicians born after 01/01/1999. Free program with a max. duration of 7 minutes.
- 6. VIRTUOSO na age limit. Free program with a max. duration of 7 minutes.
- 7. CAT. Chamber Music (Classical instrumental groups, from 2 to 9 players). Free program with a max. duration of 6 minutes.
- 8. CAT. Orchestra (Folklore and Classical instrumental groups). Free program with a max. duration of 6 minutes.
- 9. CAT. Choir and Voices. Free program with a max. duration of 6 minutes.

- 5. CAT. Chamber Music (from 7 to 12 players); with a maximum duration of 20 minutes
- 6. CAT. Wind Ensemble; with a maximum duration of 20 minutes
- 7. CAT. Wind Orchestra; with a maximum duration of 20 minutes
- 8. CAT. Orchestra pieces; with a maximum duration of 30 minutes
- 9. CAT. Voices (solo, ensemble); with a maximum duration of 10 minutes
- 10. CAT. Voices (choir); with a maximum duration of 30 minutes
- 11. CAT. Folklore Section; with a maximum duration of 10 minutes
- 12. CAT Young Composer International Prize (solo, ensemble or orchestra); applicants born on or after 1st January 2005.
- 13. CAT Young Composer International Prize (solo, ensemble or orchestra); applicants born on or after 1st January 2002.
- 14. CAT Jazz (solo, ensemble, orchestra or big band); with a maximum duration of 10 minutes
- 15. CAT Film Music; with a maximum duration of 20 minutes
- 16. CAT Electronic Music; with a maximum duration of 20 minutes

The entry fee is 50€ for 1st piece and 30 Euro for 2nd piece and 10 Euro for 3rd piece

### PRIZES:

1° CLASS. (95 - 100 points) – 500 Euro, World Premiere and 1st Prize diploma (Gold Diploma)

2° CLASS. (90 - 94,99 points) - 2nd Prize diploma (Silver diploma)

3° CLASS. (85 - 89,99 points) - 3rd Prize diploma (Bronze diploma)

The <u>Absolute Winner for each Category</u> is the competitor who gained the highest score, but not less than 98/100. - For the 1st Absolute Prize: <u>Prize off 1500 Euros</u>, World Premiere and Gold Diploma.
